School Vision

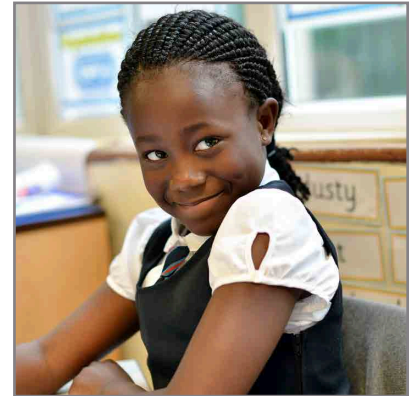
All children at this school have potential and should aim to...

Making every moment matter

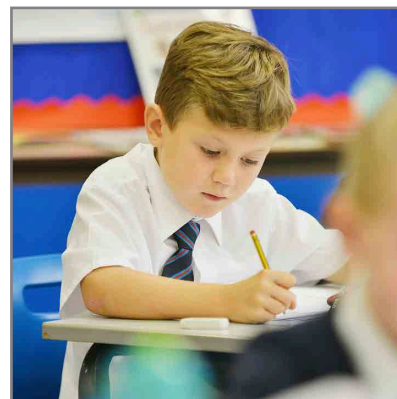
It is our intention that the aims, beliefs and values, identified in our vision permeate every aspect of learning.

High Expectations for All

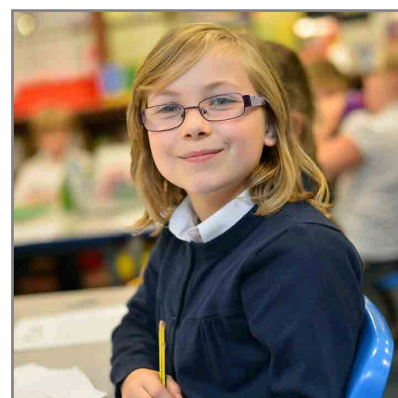
High Expectations for all learners are at the heart of good teaching and learning!
