What do you want the children to know?

Make links to the key themes and ensure a deeper understanding of the knowledge.

Application of Skills/ Disciplinary Knowledge:
What key questions will you ask the children to give them opportunity to apply their knowledge to skills?

1. To know how buildings used for leisure in Bamsley have changed over time- cinemas/theatres.

To know that cinemas haven't always been around and that people used to go to the theatre.

To understand that what people do in their free time has changed e.g. the shows they watch, more people go to the cinema than the theatre.

(use timeline to order changes)</p> <p>To use primary sources to explain how Bamsley market has changed over time.</p>	<p>To understand that as technology has advanced, so have the things people buy from stalls. e.g. phone repair stalls</p> <p>To understand that Bamsley Market is now used for leisure alongside necessities e.g. Market Kitchen, people go to socialise and have fun whereas in the past, the market was a place to buy necessary items of food etc.</p> <p>To understand that people shop elsewhere for necessities now such as supermarkets etc.</p>

<p>4. <u>To know how buildings used for leisure in Barnsley have changed over time- Barnsley Football Club.</u></p> <p>To know that Barnsley FC's football ground is called Oakwell Stadium.</p> <p>To know that Barnsley FC have played at Oakwell Stadium since 1888.</p>	<p>To understand that Oakwell is one of the only stadiums in England to still have wooden seating as others have lost them due to fires.</p>
