Learning Goal:

To know who Simone Biles is so I can explain what she does and why she is famous.

To understand that Simone Biles has had major successes in the sporting industry

To understand that Simone Biles is the most decorated gymnast in history-

- 7x Olympic medals. 4x Gold. 1x Silver. 2x Bronze.
- 30 World Championship medals. 23x Gold. 4x Silver. 3x bronze.
- Record number of World gold medals (23)
- Record number of World all-around titles (6) in the women's competition.

To understand that Simone Biles has 2 of the protected characteristics (female, black). Can the children identify why this may have been an obstacle for her during her career?

Summarise Simone Biles' background and successes.

Explain how SB's skin colour and gender may have created obstacles for her throughout her career.
