Dear Parents/Guardians,

Spring Bank Holiday 2026 and 2027 – Important Dates for Your Diary

We are pleased to confirm that the school will once again be having a two week break for the Spring Bank Holiday both this year, and again in 2027.

Please note the following:

For this year 2026 - the school and nursery will be closed from Monday 25th May until Monday 8th June 2026.

For next year 2027 - the school and nursery will be closed from Monday 24th May until Monday 7th June 2026.

Please note that the school has historically taken an additional week's holiday immediately following the standard Spring Bank Holiday week. However, due to the late date of the Spring Bank Holiday in 2027, the school will instead take this additional week before the scheduled holiday week.

We really do hope that if you are planning a holiday around this time of year, that you will take advantage of this extended break and not book holidays during term time.

This is especially important for pupils in Year 1, Year 2, Year 4 and Year 6.

All pupils in Year 1, and those in Year 2 who did not previously meet the pass mark, will need to complete their 'Phonics Screening Check'. This must be completed between Monday 8th and Friday 12th June 2026.

All pupils in Year 4 complete a 'Multiplication Check'. We have a specific time scale where this needs to be completed and for 2026 this will be from Monday 8th until Friday 12th June 2026.

The dates for Year 6 SATs for 2026 will be Monday 11th until Friday 14th May 2026. Please note that it is imperative that all pupils attend every day as they will sit a different test each morning of this week, apart from Friday.

All of these tests are statutory and therefore it is vital that all pupils are in school and can complete the tests on time, if not, then this could have implications on their future teaching and learning.

Therefore, if you are planning a holiday, please carefully consider these very important dates.
