9th – 13th June - Year 1 Phonics Screening Check

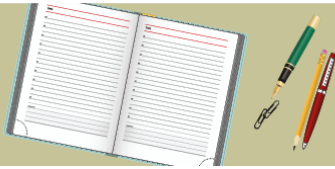

Tuesday 15th July – Rocksteady Rock Concert

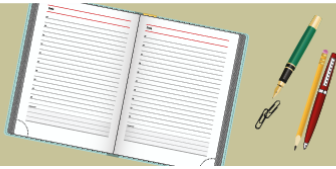
End of term concert for parents of those children who take part in Rocksteady Music Lessons. The concert will commence at 2.45pm.
